

Agenda:

Motion to approve agenda with correction of January 25th instead of 26 th by Alice Smith and Sue Johnson seconded. Motion passed.

August Minutes:

Motioned to accept the minutes with correction of striking names of bank and Investment accounts by Melissa Chester and seconded by Alice Smith. Motion passed.

Financial Report:

Steve Huffman emailed the council members October Financial Reports Total income for October was \$13220.49. Total expenses were \$11,886.23. Preschool's income was \$11064.56. Total expenses were \$8,008.39. Total Summary was \$4390.43. Checking account as of 10/31/25 is \$34,950.60. Investment fund balance on 9/30/25 was \$393,481.88. Weekly offerings have averaged \$2,460. \$3999 is needed weekly to cover operating expenses. Motion to approve financial report was made by Melissa Chester and seconded by Linda Warren.

Old Business:

Earl Mechanical – Diane reported everything to get through winter have been completed. News on a member's estate – A discussion was held on ways to show appreciation to the family. Repairs to Nave/ Fellowship Hall- Diane reported the accordion doors were fixed by Jim Ruess and Pete Myers along with half of the lights. The outside lights were fixed at the corner of the rental house.

New Business:

Events in November & December: November 23rd church going to change decorations to Christmas, and November 30th is Tuba Christmas. Christmas Eve will have one service this year at 7:00pm. Annual reports for committee chairs are requested to be turned in to the office by January 1st. Funeral, Baptism, new member family – Diane reported Pastor Bill Schultz did a funeral and the Daniel Family will be coming new members and having their youngest baptized. Congregational Meeting is scheduled for January 25th .

Committee Reports:

Childhood Ministry – Met October 29 2025. Registration remains the same. Olivia Myers has started teaching. Fall pictures were taken October 23rd. Linda Rose from Seneca County parks visited October 30th . Extended care has added several students, increasing from 51 to 55. Extended care was offered on days TCS was closed in October. Department of Children and Youth (DCY) came and did an inspection October 7th . The only write ups were for some medical forms that have not been returned. Jane will send them in when completed. The board has decided not to participate in Step Up to Quality this year.

Worship & Music – Melissa Chester reported the final revision of the Wedding guide is being completed and will be reviewed at their next meeting. Kelly King will be checking out lighting issues and giving a proposal for costs. Poinsettias were ordered by Deb Hohman and a donation of \$15.00 will be asked. Melissa continues to work on filling worship positions. Sharon Losey organized a display for Veteran's Day. Advent candles will be lit at Advent services in the same way as last year. The church secretary is organizing a new system of using offering envelopes. The envelopes will be stamped on the back for members to enter their information. More to come on this project. Next meeting will be December 3rd.

Transition Committee – It was reported they will be meeting again December 1st and then again with Pastor Poole via Zoom.

Property Report:

Reported fixing the accordion door in Fellowship Hall, and outside lights on the house and fellowship hall. Janet Zirger had a meeting with Sound Systems about better sound in our Facebook broadcast and issues with our phone system. M.J. Brown was contacted about the downspout on the northwest corner of the fellowship hall, several eave spouts which do not drain properly and some black streaking on the roof.


Finance:
